# Things to Know Before You Go

## Washington DC 3 Days/2 Nights Package (LAD5N)

1. On the first day of the tour:
    - For easy recognize, you must wear Peony Tours red round badge.
    - Arrive the appointed point in good time. Our bus will depart on time.
  2. For the sake of fairness and general comfort of the group, rules will be set for daily seat rotation.
  3. Refrain from talking when tour guide is speaking.
  4. We suggest you wear comfortable clothes and water repellent walking shoes. A raincoat or umbrella is also recommended to bring in your handbag.
  5. Be sure you have all travel documents before leaving for the trip. Keep your passport, air ticket, money, credit card, cash and other valuables with you at all time. Never leave them in the coach or in hotel rooms.
  6. Be cautious when staying at a hotel. Never allow strangers into your rooms. Cooking and smoking are not allowed in hotel room. When hear an alarm in hotel, you should immediately and quickly leave to get to safety.
  7. Most of rooms in hotel have two beds each. When three or four people share a room and want extra bed, you may put a request at the hotel front desk.
  8. Tipping is customary and rewards quality service. Peony Tours suggests tipping in the following manner: US\$6 per person per day - to be distributed between tour guide and driver. However, the final amount is at your discretion.
  9. Weather/Temperature: Washington is located in the humid subtropical climate zone, exhibiting four distinct seasons. Spring and fall are warm, with low humidity, while winter is cool, with annual snowfall averaging 37cm. Average winter lows tend to be around 30°F from mid-December to mid-February. Summer is hot and humid, with the July high and low averaging 85°F., though the high will surpass 95°F.
  10. Things you should know while sightseeing:
    - While sightseeing program is specified in the itinerary, its final arrangement will be determined by the tour guide, based on circumstances which are beyond the control of Peony Tours, such as weather, acts of God, dangers, strike, breakdown in machinery or equipments, acts of government or authorities, road works under local condition.
    - Our sightseeing schedule is compact and requires every tour member's highly cooperation. Kindly notify the tour guide if for any reasons you need to deviate from the tour.
  - Throughout the tour, the tour guide will arrange the travel logistics for the tour group. Please be on time and follow the tour guide's instructions.
  - Passengers' safety has always been our number one concern. For your safety, if you plan to go out at night or roam at free time alone, you should notify your tour guide ahead of time.
  - Refrain from noise when visiting Princeton University.
  - Respect Amish religion and observe their customs when visiting Amish Village.
  - Washington D.C., the capital of the United States, has a collection of free, public museums unparalleled in size and scope throughout the history of mankind, and the lion's share of the nation's most treasured monuments and memorials. It attracts thousands of visitors each year. Visitors must observe the rules while visiting museums.
  - The White House and the Capitol are rarely open to the public. Since our tour is on an extremely tight schedule, as a result, we won't be able to visit the inside.
